International Competition of Student Scientific Works "Integrated Transportation Systems and Technologies" is dedicated to stimulating the scientific activity of higher education students, developing international cooperation in the field of science, exchanging experience between higher education institutions, and encouraging the solution of urgent problems of transport infrastructure. The competition is organized for the Day of Science in Ukraine.

Competition Tracks

- Smart transport and integrated transport technologies;
- Transportation systems and logistics;
- Safety and road traffic management;
- Staffing of higher education institutions and transport industry enterprises;
- Mathematical applied problems in the transport industry.

Competition Requirements

Participants of the Competition can be students from higher education institutions of Ukraine and other countries who are studying in bachelor's or master's programs. Scientific work should be prepared individually or collectively by creative group (no more than two people). Up to ten scientific works in each track from one higher education institution can participate in the Competition.

The Competition will be held in two stages: correspondence (review of works), final (includes online presentation of works to the jury; report - in Ukrainian or English, presentation material - exclusively in English).

Important dates

Work submission – until April 10, 2025.
Reviewing works and selection of the best works – until April 30, 2025.
Holding a final conference – until May 16, 2025.

Work requirements

1. The text must be typed in Times New Roman, font size 14, line spacing 1.5, A4 sheet.
2. The text should not exceed 24 pages, excluding appendices.
3. The work must have a title and content, a list of references. Additionally, an extended abstract (2-3 pages) in English or Ukrainian should be provided. It must indicate the relevance, goal, objectives, research methodology, general characteristics of the work, keywords.
4. Copies of the author's patents, scientific articles, etc. (if available) are attached to the work.
5. Scientific works should be prepared in Ukrainian or English. The text of the paper must be written without spelling, punctuation, and stylistic errors.
6. To participate in the Competition, you must submit a package of participant's papers, which includes:
 - participant application form;
 - the text of the scientific work;
 - a review (recommendation) of the scientific supervisor in any form;
 - an extended abstract;
 - a certificate of plagiarism check.
