#### Purpose of the meeting

The 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting of a Working Group 5 on Road Traffic Safety, is a part of the CSS II project in Kharkiv Region. The purpose was to discuss what activities could be possible under the quarantine measures due to COVID-19 situation in the world and using the teleworking mode.

#### **Content (key points)**

- 1) SA on GP Tuomo Korhonen praised Patrol Police for the great quality activities (videos, social ads) they do on their social media channels (Facebook, Instagram etc.);
- 2) The UkrAvtodor interactive map of Ukraine's Roads: the map is developed by UkrAvtodor and is used nationwide. The Roads Service in Kharkiv Region drafted a letter addressed to the UkrAvtodor HQ and shared the minutes of the meeting dated 10 March 2020 with them.
- 3) The KHADI course on Audit of RTS for police officers in Kharkiv Region dealing with RTAs: according to representative from KHADI University the possibility of the course depends on when the quarantine in Ukraine will be over. After the end of quarantine, KHADI will need approximately one week to prepare all the documents for the course and they will need a letter of request from EUAM to conduct the course. The curriculum of the course was updated by KHADI, it includes 108 hours of learning process. The could be a possibility to have this course in June, because the teachers

from KHADI university will be taking their annual leaves starting from 6 July. KHADI supports the idea of including other organizations into participants list.

Yevhenii Voloshyn, Deputy Head of Preventive Activities Department of MDNP in Kharkiv Region, noted that NPU don't have experts in RTS who can contribute to the curriculum of the course. There are experts in the RTS unit of the Department of Patrol Police in Kharkiv Region, so he would like to ask for feedback from them (in particular Yevhen Petrov) about the curriculum and adapt it to the needs of police. Voloshyn can prepare a list of issues that NPU officers have to deal with on spot regarding RTS.

All the information about the course should go to Vira Kovalenko (FO Kharkiv Regional Operations Officers).

4) RTS week in May 2020: according to the representative of Kharkiv Patrol Police they haven't received any official information yet from their HQ in Kyiv about the exact dates of the week. There are more people using private vehicles now during the quarantine than before it started. But the WG5 can have an information/awareness campaign on RTS on the Internet/Social Media. SA on GP suggested to develop a draft plan of campaign for the nest meeting of WG5 and each organization can think how can they contribute to the campaign.

### **Follow-up actions:**

- WG5 members to draft a list of bullet points with legislation and internal SOPs in their organizations which prevent the sharing of information about RTAs with each other and use of interactive map;
- Develop a plan for the RTS campaign on Internet/Social Media (name of campaign, hashtags, activities etc.);
- Yevhenii Voloshyn to provide a list of issues that NPU police officers in Kharkiv Region face when dealing with RTAs on spot;
- Next meeting will take place via Skype on 15 April 2020 at 14:00.
